

Task Force Member

This course is designed to prepare students who become a member of an HMERT Task Force (EMS Task Force). It will help participants understand the components of a Task Force, appropriate Task Force missions, and the basic standards of conduct.

Task Force Commander

This course is designed for the individual who will be taking a command role in a Task Force. On completion of the class participants will better understand Task Force organization and administration, emergency alerting, mobilization, deployment, operations, and logistics.

Prerequisite – Task Force Member

Strike Team Member

This course is designed to prepare individuals to become a member of an HMERT Strike Team (CISM, Physician, Massage Therapy). It will help them understand how the system responds to disasters, as well as their role in the disaster response process.

Strike Team Leader

This course is designed for the individual who will be taking a command role on a Strike Team. It will help the participant understand the processes involved in alerting, mobilization, and mission tasking, as well as other Strike Team procedures.

Prerequisite – Strike Team Member

Mass Casualty Incident Management III

Module III will prepare individuals who are placed in the role of EMS Sector Officer at the scene of a mass casualty. Although this class is open to all individuals meeting the criteria, it is aimed those individuals that will serve in a command role at a Mass Casualty Incident.

Prerequisites – Mass Casualty Incident Management I and II

Mass Casualty Incident Management IV

Module IV will prepare students who are placed in the role of Emergency Support Function 8 officer at the local Emergency Operations Center during an ongoing event.

Prerequisites – Mass Casualty Incident Management I and II
