\*\*When responding to a possible ALS call, request Med channel *and* tower assignment. This assignment will be given on Med 10, EMS 1 or EMS 2. Assignments are made according to location; give clear geographic location when requesting assignment.

Med 9 - Helicopter operations

EMS 1 - Patient reports, Med channel assignment

EMS 2 - Patient reports, Med channel assignment
